This information has been emailed to DC's and Branch and Club Secretaries in the OSPC Area. Could Club Secretaries please check that all Branch Secretaries and DC's have received this information? Entries close on the 16/10/09. Please get your entries in early so we can do the draw for any draft riders and have time to notify riders and teams who has been drawn into which teams.

Please include at the time of entry:

Team entry form signed by the DC, Riders profile forms, Helpers form, stabling/yards bookings and all money to cover your costs involved.

Late entries will incur a 50% extra fee increase.

Booking loose boxes and/or yards after the entry date will incur a \$10.00 late fee.

Any changes to combinations after the entry date will need to be confirmed by the DC.

Remember the Organizing Committee has the right to accept or refuse teams alterations.

The District Commissioners approval of the change will assist the committee to make the final decision.

There will be a shop on the ground.

No dogs.

Otago Southland Pony Club Team Show Jumping Championships.

7th and 8th November 2009

Taieri A & P Showgrounds – Mosgiel.

Entries Close 16/10/09

(Late entries will incur a 50% fee increase.)

Accommodation for horses: Horse accommodation at the showgrounds will cost \$10 for the older style loose boxes each day, \$20.00 for the new style loose boxes for each day and \$10 for a yard for each day. Please indicate which you would prefer. Loose boxes will be allocated on the basis of first requests received (with payment) to be given first priority.

Penalty

There is a \$20.00 penalty per horse yard/box if the yards or loose boxes are left untidy. This will be invoiced to the team/individual responsible. The committee will police the yards/boxes during presentations to ensure other teams/individuals do not use yards/boxes already cleaned up. A yard/box token system will operate where the manager will hand over the token when they are satisfied that the yard/box is satisfactorily cleaned and the committee will inspect the yard/box to confirm this. Tokens will be handed out with back numbers.

Camping on the Ground: Please leave your camp area clean and tidy. Showers are available at a cost of \$5.00 per shower. Please pay at the secretary's office.

Teams: A team may be entered from a Branch or a Club of Otago Southland Pony Club, consisting of at least 4 riders (1 in each section, and 1 other), and up to six riders (2 in each section). Riders must be available to ride for their Branch as first priority, then their Club if there is no space for them in a Branch team. There are to be no short-term transfers (of less than 3 months) of riders from other clubs/branches or areas, as the draft rider system is preferred.

Any riders who do not get a space in either their Branch or Club team can be entered as an individual, and where possible these riders will be drafted into any gaps in other teams. If there are no gaps available they will compete as individual competitors.

Riders may ride only one mount.

Competitors must have attended 5 rallies in the past 12 months, three of these on the mount on which they are competing.

Riders, including Draft riders must name 2 events in which they have competed in the height in which they are to be entered and finished live, on the mount they will be riding.

Start Times

On Saturday, we will start at 10.00 with a mounted parade (time to be confirmed later), in the warm up area, followed by the start of the FEI competition at 11.00. The Show Jumping Courses will be open before the mounted parade.

On Sunday the FEI events will start at 9am.

Competitions for the weekend include two TA5's (one with an instant jump off), one TA2 and one Article 274.5.2. These are run under the New Zealand Equestrian Federation rules for show jumping.

TA5:

Adding the penalties for faults at the obstacles and the time penalties gives the score obtained by the competitor for the round.

In the event of equality of penalties for first place, there will be one jump off against the clock. Other competitors are placed according to their penalties, and time, in the first round.

Instant Jump Off:

If a competitor is clear over the initial course, the starting bell will be rung again for this competitor to commence their jump off against the clock.

Article 274. 5.2:

This is a two-phase competition run without interruption. The finishing line for the first phase is also the starting line for the second phase. The first phase is not against the clock but has a time allowed. The second phase is against the clock. Competitors who have penalties in the first phase are stopped at the end of this phase by the judge ringing the bell. Competitors with no penalties in the first round continue straight on to the second phase.

TA2: Adding the penalties for faults at the obstacles and the time penalties gives the score obtained by the competitor for the round. Competitors with equality of penalties for any place are placed in accordance with the time taken to complete the round. In the event of equality of penalties and time for the first place, there may be a jump-off over a shortened course.

- ❖ Sashes for first 6 teams (all members).
- ❖ Individual rosettes to 10 placings in each class.
- ❖ The following trophies are to be awarded:
 - **Telford Rural Polytechnic Trophy** for the team gaining most points over the weekend.
Teams score for the Telford Trophy will be the accumulation of their best score from each age group plus their next best score. If equality of points should occur, their next best scores would be considered. If after considering all six scores, equality still remains, their total of clear rounds will be used to determine placings
 - **Campbell Family Trophy for the S.O.P.C. team** gaining most points over the weekend.
 - **CRT Trophy for Horse mastership.**
 - **OMR Trophy for Fair Play**, from the time entries' are received.
 - **Williamson Trophy for the best turned out team.** (Plus rosettes for the top three teams)
Turnout will be judged on cleanliness of gear, horse and rider, presentation in correct uniform and the correct gear not the newest or best gear/uniform. E.g. if a rider presents in incorrect or unsafe turnout (uniform and gear) for Show jumping they will not be awarded full points for this trophy.
- ❖ The Scoring system used will be the same one as the NZPCA South Island Show Jumping Champs.
- ❖ Points to 10th placing. (Points allocated: 1st = 15 points ---> 10th = 6 points .First Round, elimination or disqualification = 0 points. First Round with penalties =1 point. Clear first round = 2 points, 2nd clear round = 5 points. Therefore unplaced double clear rounds finish on 7 points. TA2 Elimination = 0 points, round with penalties =2 points, clear round=5 points.
i.e. 1st = 15 points plus 2 points for first clear round = 17 points, 2nd = 14 points plus 2 points = 16 points, 3rd = 13 points plus 2 points = 15 points; and so on to 10th = 6 points plus 2 points = 8 points.
 - ❖ The committee's decision shall be final.
 - ❖ The committee reserves the right to alter the schedule.
 - ❖ The committee reserves the right to ballot out teams if entry numbers exceed the limit.
