Policy on School Sports Awards and Colours

Purpose

To give schools a framework to apply School Sports Awards and Colours to Equestrian achievers.

Procedure

- Candidates must obtain achievement in equestrian competition in their chosen discipline/s and demonstrate good sportsmanship.
- Results must be presented in writing and have been verified by an official at the competition.
- To assist schools, three levels of achievement are detailed below, schools may apply additional requirements at any chosen level, depending on their existing policies.

Criteria

Sports Award – level 1

- Candidates to have achieved Area, Club or Branch representation at national, regional or provincial competition.
- School representation as a member of the Schools Equestrian team.

Sports Blue – level 2

- Candidates to have achieved national, provincial or regional representation and posted an individual or team performance at that competition. [First four placing]. If a team competition the candidates score must have contributed.

Sports Elite – level 3

- Candidates to have achieved national selection representation either as an individual or a team member. [e.g. NZPCA Inter Pacific Team member, ESNZ Show Jumping Team member, World Championship representative, etc]

- Candidates to have achieved national selection representation either as an individual or a team member. [e.g. NZPCA Inter Pacific Team member, ESNZ Show Jumping Team member, World Championship representative, etc]
